 - ★ Stallions must be registered purebreds and shown by an exhibitor 18 years or older.
 - ★ Ponies must be 56" or under.
 - ★ All exhibitors must be 6 years of age as of January 1st of the fair year.
 - ★ No new entries or changes made after the show starts.
 - ★ Each exhibitor must handle their own animal.
 - ★ Proof of a current year's negative Coggins test is required for all horses on the fairgrounds. Coggins at arrival.
 - ★ No horses are allowed on the grounds before 1pm on Thursday.
 - ★ There will be no reserving of stalls. Stalls are first come first serve after 1pm on Thursday, after check of Coggins.
 - ★ No horses are allowed in the back ballfield camping area.
- Walk Trot exhibitors may only ride in Walk Trot classes, excluding Speed and Action. Walk Trot exhibitors may enter Speed and Action.
